Introduction.

In the scientific research centers of the countries of the leading countries in Europe and Asia, the periodical press, which has a rapid impact on the human mind, collects, compares, and analyzes the information of the peoples of the region, distinguishing the specific features of the state administration that formed them, and conducts important scientific researches on the study of the main aspects of the existing problems. In particular, historical data such as mutual conflicts, problems, cultural and economic crises, internal disputes, cross-border disputes specific to the region, water disputes, and the fact that the role of the periodical press in covering the debates has attracted the attention of politicians, determines the important theoretical and scientific necessity of the topic.

Materials and Methods.

In particular, the researches of I. Karimov, S. Atamuradov, A. Mavrulov, B. Rahimov and others, published during the years of independence, studied the political, socio-economic and cultural situation of the studied period. Also, in a number of monographs and articles, he partially covered the economic,

social, and cultural conditions in Uzbekistan and its regions in the pre-independence period from an objective and critical point of view. These studies are mainly works published in Russian, and they tried to substantiate their opinions by referring to the memoirs of state leaders and politicians, as well as periodical press, archival funds, and statistical data. Despite the large number of studies conducted on the subject, in them, sharp differences can be seen in terms of the problem raised, the researcher's attitude to the information in the sources, the research methods used, the sources and works selected for research, the geography of the research, and the objectivity of the conclusions.

Results and discussion.

The fact that the Surkhandarya region is bordered by Tajikistan in the North, Northeast, and East, Turkmenistan in the West, and Afghanistan, one of the hot spots of the earth, in the South by the Amudarya river, requires that the consciousness of the population should be constantly awake. In such circumstances, the press has a great responsibility. More serious articles and dedication are required from the media of Surkhan.

It can be noted that in 2016, more than 30 newspapers, 2 magazines, 5 television stations and one radio station are operating in the region.

Almost all publications of the region have published articles on love for the motherland, humanitarian spirit, and at the same time, problems such as human trafficking, drug addiction, fanaticism. In particular, the social and political newspapers of the regional administration "Surkhan Tongi" and "Zarya Surkhan" deserve special recognition. The publication is published twice a week. On the pages of this newspaper, articles and materials rich in facts about the socio-political and economic life of the region are published. Special attention is paid to the promotion of local people's lifestyle and activities, political rights, literature and art in newspaper publications.

Many analytical and critical articles are also published in "Sariosiyo" newspaper published in Sarosiy district. This is definitely a team effort. In particular, published on May 27, 2016, "Child education is an important factor", "Stability and peace is the main factor of development", "Who killed millions of people?" articles like Today, each of us has a phone, a tablet, a laptop. True, it is difficult to imagine today's era without them, but everything has a measure. The newspaper also published an article entitled "Effects of Cell Phones on Health" enriched with clear facts about their harm. "Radiation from the phone is relatively high, especially when the call is ringing. To do this, if you move the phone 10 centimeters away from the ear, the level of radiation will decrease 100 times. In addition, it is advisable to hold the phone at a distance of 1 centimeter when talking. According to scientific conclusions, the negative effect of the phone on brain cells begins after 13-15 seconds.

Child education is a constant issue. Due to its subtlety, some people can do it, and some people don't. In our country, upbringing is not separated from education. Parents and teachers work together for the development of the child. "Saliqchi minbari" newspaper covers a lot of legal articles, but social articles are also covered,

for example, in the March 16, 2017 issue of the newspaper, "Can the family and school be brought closer together?" published an article. Today, the relationship between school and family is more complicated. Some parents barely bother to attend parent-teacher conferences once or twice a year. So that his child's face does not turn red the next day. The article discusses this problem in detail.

The role of the father in the family is incomparable. He is a support both mentally and physically. But not all fathers are like that. In the July 30, 2018 issue of the "Sound of Sand" publication, the article entitled "Unnecessary fathers" is written about one of the "fathers" who is indifferent to the tears of his children, abandons them and even refuses to pay alimony.

Once upon a time, important articles were published in the "Chaganiyon" newspaper, which spread throughout the republic. One of the advantages and achievements of this newspaper is that in the July 28, 2016 issue of this newspaper, "Our bloodline is our soul", "The most delicate culture", "Mubarak Dargah breezes" in analytical and critical spirit, "Let's prevent waste", "Liver tube", "To the principles" articles such as "Business", "Forgers" were published. Although the newspaper is a district publication, it is evident that it strives for excellence. In it, important elements such as lead and column, which are hardly found in other local publications, are permanently placed. In addition, articles on political life with titles such as "Tax Refused", "Applications Satisfied", "Dedicated to the Implementation of Labor Laws" were published.

"Oltinsoy Tongi" newspaper of Oltinsoy district can also observe the problems in the lives of local residents and their solutions.

"Is this the attention to our Uzbek national language?" published in the May 27, 2016 issue of "Sariosiyo" newspaper. The article with the title discusses the sanctity of our language, our preservation and consideration. For example: "Answering letters, reports, references, applications, keeping company documents were all required to be kept (written) in Russian. Do you know how difficult it is to do it in another

language while staying in one's mother tongue?" And in another sentence: "You know, the Uzbek proverb says that the true Uzbek word is 'Lets the snake out of its den.'" Quotation marks are not used when the adverb in the sentence is turned into a possessive clause. There are different versions of the proverb. One of them is as follows: "A good word pulls a snake out of its den, and a bad word pulls a knife out of its sheath."

There are many articles about cases of law violations, court essays, published in the "Crime and Punishment" column in district publications. For example, in the March 16 issue of the "Taxman's Minbari" newspaper, "The mind is not at that age...", "Sorcerer or Fraudster", "The Act of the Second Wife" published in the January 30, 2016 issue of the "Khalk Posboni" newspaper, "He does what he sees in the bird's nest", "The Thief Woman", "Family Entrepreneurs", "The Thief's Deed", "The Consequences of Inhumanity", "Looking for One's Own Interest" in the April 29, 2016 issue of the "Sariosiyo" newspaper, "Kingir Ish...", "The Thief Can't Be Right" in the March 26 issue. like This, of course, calls the population to be aware.

Every business has its own rules. Knowing and learning it is the task of a specialist. In our national journalism, attention to the issue of design is weaker. Many of our publications have problems with the external image of the newspaper, the placement of articles, pictures, fonts, and color harmony. But today, attention to newspapers is much weaker, because paper media are replaced by modern social networks and instant messengers, which are used by almost everyone.

In the article "Nonpazlar" published in "Surkhan Tongi" newspaper, there is information about the local residents of Angor district in baking and the passing of this art from generation to generation and its secrets. On December 26, in connection with the cultivation of a ton of cotton, artists, wrestlers and wrestlers from the district were invited to a double holiday, the "Harvest Day" and the 40th anniversary of the establishment of Angor District [3].

Taking into account the suggestions and opinions of citizens and public representatives with the leadership of the Regional Council of Trade Unions, it was decided to establish the Sabir at Termizi award for our famous compatriot, enlightening writer, in connection with the celebration of the first anniversary of the independence of the Republic of Uzbekistan. The purpose of this is to restore and strengthen our national traditions and values, to develop culture and art, artistic and folk creativity, to contribute to the improvement of journalistic and performance skills, and to educate the population aesthetically. At the same time, the Sabir al-Tirmizi award winner award was established. Badges and commemorative diplomas were also prepared for those who deserve the award. The Regulation on the award, the procedure for awarding it, and the selection group of regional trade unions were also approved. The Regional Council of Trade Unions and Branch Committees allocate the necessary amount of expenses for the approval of the awardees and other expenses. Writers for the award are recommended by journalists, poets, performers and artists, creative and artistic amateur groups, architects, sculptors, organizations and institutions, trade union committee. The works and programs were sent to the Council of Regional Trade Unions (F.Khojayev Street, 17, Termiz city) by July 1. The award will be given on the Independence Day of the Republic of Uzbekistan on September 1 and will be announced in the newspapers "Ishanch" and "Surkhan Tongi" [4].

In 1992, a 40-bed children's hospital for infectious diseases equipped with the most modern medical equipment was launched in Termiz.

As a result of gaining independence, some newspapers in the region changed their names. For example, the names of the newspapers "Lelin Bairoghi" and "Lelinskoe znamya" were changed to "Surkhan Tongi" and "Zarya Surkhana", respectively, while the name of the newspaper "Lelin Yoli" was also changed to "Kiziriq Vozi".

Also, in the "Surkhan Tongi" newspaper, articles such as "Chekanka began", "Toyga tyona bilan",

"A tree planted with hope", "Ramp in the Termiz market" are also focused on domestic and moral issues among the population.

Conclusion.

The role of mass media in the life of this nation is significant in covering the socio-political and economic role of each nation. Today, although the mass media has become electronic, the importance of newspapers, magazines and other mass media in the late 20th century and the first decade of the 21st century is incomparable.
