This principle

is not new, but so far it does not have a single and generally accepted definition. Another frequently used innovative technology for teaching a foreign language is a role-playing game, in which participants imagine themselves in a certain situation (for example, in a cafe, airport, theater, etc.). Role-playing games are an effective way to teach students practical work skills, it is used to master new material. strengthen and develop creative abilities, as well as solve complex problems of forming general educational skills. The effectiveness of teaching is that it increases motivation, interest in science, creates speech activity and, as a result, develops it, because the student has to say, ask, prove something. In addition, not only the speaker, but also the listener is active, because he must understand and remember the note of the partner, analyze it and respond if necessary. Based on this, we can say that roleplaying games develop not only conversation, but also the ability to hear, as well as critical thinking.

Another method is a conversation, conducted orally in pairs, the main goal of which is to develop communication skills. The teacher asks questions on a certain topic, asks students to ask each other. The advantages of this method of teaching a foreign language are the practical application of the newly learned grammatical structure, its use in live speech, and the development of speaking skills. In addition, it is suitable for students of all levels. For example, if the audience's level is A1 or A2, then the teacher prepares questions on general topics, but if the level is B1, B2 or higher, the teacher only gives a topic and allows students to independently may ask to compose questions, or ask both topics and questions that are difficult to answer. answer because they are unexpected.

Discussion is another important way of teaching a foreign language, and its essence is to discuss current topics (for example, school uniforms, global warming, etc.). As in the above methods, discussions encourage students to think about the problem, show tolerance, apply all available knowledge and develop conversational skills. In addition, this technique helps introverted students to "open up" and express their thoughts. After all, if they have

their own well-defined point of view on a certain issue, they want to share it and know other people's reactions.

It is also important to emphasize the role of the teacher in all teaching methods. In this context, the teacher can play the role of a curator (to help when there is a difficulty in the language plan), an observer (to observe the progress of the game, comment on what is happening, give advice) or together with the students., try the participant role

In conclusion, it should be said that innovative pedagogical technologies play a major role in foreign language teaching, because they allow the development of various language and practical skills and prevent the concept of "talking about the language instead of communicating in the language".

Innovative technologies are designed to help people move forward and improve their habitats. The teacher is free to choose one or another technology for each group.

Interactivity not only creates real life situations, but also makes you respond adequately to them through a foreign language. And when it starts to turn out, you can talk about language competence.
