ABSTRACT

This article presents a historical and analytical study of the service activities of several officers who have served within the system of the Internal Affairs Bodies of Surkhandarya Region during the years of Uzbekistan's independence. The research analyzes the professional careers of officers working in criminal investigation, crime prevention, public safety, and road traffic safety sectors. The findings demonstrate the consistent development of personnel training and leadership formation systems within the internal affairs bodies and reveal that the professional experience of officers has become one of the key factors in maintaining law and order in the region.

Introduction

Following the independence of the Republic of Uzbekistan, extensive reforms were implemented in the system of internal affairs bodies alongside reforms in all spheres of public administration. The primary objectives of these reforms were to protect the rights and freedoms of citizens, maintain public order, combat crime, and strengthen public trust in state institutions. The Internal Affairs Bodies of Surkhandarya Region actively participated in these transformation processes. The professional training, practical experience, and service performance of officers serving in the region constitute important factors determining the effectiveness of internal affairs institutions. Therefore, studying the service activities of internal affairs officers from a historical perspective, analyzing the stages of their professional development, and introducing the achieved results into academic circulation possess significant scientific relevance.

The purpose of this study is to examine the service activities of selected officers serving in the Internal Affairs Bodies of Surkhandarya

Region from a historical and analytical perspective and to highlight the outcomes of personnel policies implemented within the internal affairs system during the years of independence.

Materials And Methods

The source base of the study consists of historical and biographical publications dedicated to the activities of the Internal Affairs Bodies of Surkhandarya Region, particularly the books and collections entitled "Termiz shahar ichki ishlar boshqarmasi: Tarix, bugun va kelajak", "El tinchligi – yurt boyligi", "Osoyishta hayot jonkuyarlari", "Sharafli kasbni tanlaganlar" and "Qiziriq tumani ichki ishlar bo'limi faoliyati". These sources contain biographical information, career histories, position changes, and practical service activities of officers who have served or are currently serving in the Internal Affairs Bodies of Surkhandarya Region.

The study was conducted in accordance with the principles of historicity, objectivity, and systematicity. Historical-analytical, historical-comparative, biographical, retrospective, and

generalization methods were employed. The historical-analytical method was used to examine the service activities and professional development processes of internal affairs officers. Through biographical analysis, the career paths, promotion stages, and professional experiences of individual officers were explored. The historical-comparative method facilitated comparisons among officers serving in different operational fields. Furthermore, the generalization method enabled the systematization of the collected data and the formulation of scientific conclusions regarding the distinctive features of personnel training and service organization within the Internal Affairs Bodies of Surkhandarya Region during the years of independence.

Results

The career trajectories of officers serving in the Internal Affairs Bodies of Surkhandarya Region during the years of independence are of considerable importance for understanding personnel training and leadership development mechanisms within the system.

Major Otabek Shukurullayevich Davlatov, Head of the Criminal Investigation Division of the Operational Search Service of the Termez City Department of Internal Affairs, was born on November 24, 1991, in Denau. He is Uzbek by nationality, holds a higher education degree, and specializes in law. He graduated from the Academy of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Uzbekistan in 2013. O.S. Davlatov studied at the Academy from 2009 to 2013; served as a Prevention Inspector in the Crime Prevention Unit of the Denau District Department of Internal Affairs from 2013 to 2015; worked as an Operational Officer in the "Zevar" Criminal Investigation Unit serving the Sariosiyo District territory from 2015 to 2017; served as an Operational Officer in the Criminal Investigation and Organized Crime Department of the Denau District Department of Internal Affairs in 2017; as Senior Operational Officer of the Group for Combating Illicit Drug Trafficking from 2017 to 2018; as an Operational Officer of the Regional Criminal Investigation Department from 2018 to 2019; as Senior Inspector-Duty Officer of Duty Unit No. 1 of the Denau District

Internal Affairs Operational Department from 2019 to 2021; as an Operational Officer of the Criminal Investigation Group of the Denau District Department of Internal Affairs from 2021 to 2022; and as Senior Operational Officer of the Criminal Investigation Unit of the Termez District Department of Internal Affairs from February to September 2022. Since September 2022, he has been serving as Head of the Criminal Investigation Division of the Operational Search Service of the Termez City Department of Internal Affairs [1].

Major Salohiddin Juramurodovich Imomqulov, Head of the Criminal Investigation Unit of the Operational Search Service of the Jarqo'rg'on District Department of Internal Affairs of Surkhandarya Region, was born on May 22, 1986, in Qiziriq District. He is Tajik by nationality, holds a higher education degree, and specializes in applied mathematics. He graduated from Termez State University in 2009. During the first eleven months of 2022, S.J. Imomqulov carried out significant work in maintaining public order, ensuring public safety, preventing crimes and offenses, solving crimes in hot pursuit, uncovering previously unsolved crimes, and locating wanted criminals and missing persons [2].

Lieutenant Manzura Chori qizi Jo'rayeva, Senior Inspector for Women's Issues of the Crime Prevention Unit under the Public Safety Service of the Qumqo'rg'on District Department of Internal Affairs, was born on November 29, 1994, in Qumqo'rg'on District. She graduated from Termez State University in 2018. She served in the Bandixon District Department of Internal Affairs from 2020 to 2022 and has been serving in the Qumqo'rg'on District Department of Internal Affairs since July 2022. During the first eleven months of 2022, M.Ch. Jo'rayeva facilitated the issuance of 479 protection orders to women subjected to harassment and violence. Administrative offenses were identified among eight individuals who had been issued protection orders, and measures were taken against them pursuant to Article 206¹ of the Code of Administrative Responsibility [3].

Lieutenant Colonel Mirmuxamed Abduzairovich Ishkarayev, Head of the Uzun District

Department of Internal Affairs, was born on March 30, 1982, in Termez City. He is Tajik by nationality and holds a higher education degree. He graduated from the O'. Zokirov Republican Legal Lyceum in Fergana and later studied at the Academy of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Uzbekistan. During his career, he served in various operational and managerial positions within the Termez City Department of Internal Affairs and the Regional Department of Internal Affairs. Since March 2020, he has been serving as Head of the Uzun District Department of Internal Affairs [4].

Lieutenant Colonel Suxrob Melikmurodovich Ismailov, First Deputy Head of the Qiziriq District Department of Internal Affairs and Head of the Operational Search Service, was born on March 11, 1983, in Sariosiyo District. He is Uzbek by nationality and holds a higher education degree. He graduated from the Academy of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Uzbekistan in 2004. From 2004 to 2019, he served in various positions within the Sariosiyo District Department of Internal Affairs, the Sharg'un City Police Unit, and the Criminal Investigation and Counter-Terrorism Department of the Surkhandarya Regional Department of Internal Affairs. He acquired substantial experience, particularly in combating narcotics trafficking and the illegal circulation of drugs [5].

Captain Aziz Turg'unovich Toshpo'latov, Senior Inspector of the Road Traffic Safety Group under the Public Safety Service of the Muzrabot District Department of Internal Affairs, was born on February 23, 1986, in Termez City. Since June 2022, he has been serving as Senior Inspector of

Discussion
