It is no secret that today's worldrenowned higher education institutions are considered key scientific centers. Now, new universities and branches of world-renowned universities are being formed. In the previous five years, for example, 47 new higher education institutions, including branches of international universities, have opened in our country, bringing the total number of higher education institutions to 125. The activities of non-governmental higher education institutions are initiated on the basis of the Public-Private Partnership system. After studying public sentiment, correspondence and evening forms of education have been reintroduced, and admission quotas have been enhanced. The percentage of school graduates enrolled in higher education increased from 9% in 2016 to 25% in 2020. It was established to ensure professors and teachers' professional development and internships at higher education and research institutes around the world. In comparison to the previous year, their monthly wage climbed by 2.5 times on average. Ten higher educational institutions have been switched to the self-financing system since this year.

A number of responsibilities for the development of the social sphere, particularly education and science, are set forth in the proclamation of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan "on the strategy of actions for the continued development of the Republic of Uzbekistan" dated February 7, 2017. The document calls for the material and technical foundations of educational institutions to be strengthened, as well as the construction, repair, and capital repair of new educational institutions, as well as the provision of modern laboratory educational and equipment. computer equipment, and educational and methodical manuals.

"The tasks of higher education systems in the strategy of new Uzbekistan:

- Along with reaching the goal of 50% coverage for higher education, the main focus will be on enhancing education quality. Up until 2026, will be included in prestigious international ratings;
- Nearly 100,000-seat student dormitories will be restored in the next five years to improve students' living conditions;
- Up until 2026, the number of private households will reach at least 50 units in order to create a competitive environment in higher education.
- President Shavkat Mirziyoyev highlighted in his pre-election program that "admission to the PhD is carried out on the basis of governmental order and payment-grant from the account of money of interested groups."

This is an example of teaching lessons based not only on novel educational technologies, but also on exceptional learning, a new attitude toward education, the acquisition of necessary and deep theoretical knowledge, and the construction of practical skills, all in response to labor market demand.

In conclusion, In recent years, several educational innovations and changes have helped to an improvement in the quality of education in this Indian educational system.
