Further development of opera and ballet in our country, improvement of the Alisher Navoi State Academic Theater of Uzbekistan, wide promotion of national opera and ballet, further strengthening of its place and position in the world art and the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Shavkat Mirzivovev on May 26, 2020 signed a decree "On measures to further enhance the role and impact of culture and art in society." The resolution sets tasks to further develop the art of opera and ballet in our country, to improve the activities of the Alisher Navoi State Academic Theater of Uzbekistan, to strengthen its role and place in the world of art. The program of measures for further development of opera and ballet for 2022-2026 was also approved. Choreography at the Uzbek State Academy of Choreography The Vocal Academy and the Creative Workshop on Opera and Ballet, a 70-member Veterans' Orchestra will be established at the Alisher Navoi State Academic Theater of Uzbekistan. The document also stipulates that the republican competitions of young vocalists in February, young ballet dancers in April, conductors, directors and choreographers in June will be held annually to identify talented young people in the field of opera and ballet. Winners of the main prize and 1st place of these republican competitions will be admitted to study on the basis of additional state grants to the bachelor's admission quota of the relevant state higher education institutions in the relevant areas of education.

It is the largest genre of opera and music. It is based on a libretto, a poetic dramatic play that meets the requirements of the composer. The opera is also a theatrical performance, all the decorations, costumes, dance moves, etc serve to reveal the theme of the play, the period of the event. The fact that opera, one of the greatest musical genres in the world, has entered the culture of life of the Uzbek people is a clear demonstration of its prestige among the peoples of the world. Derived from the Latin well as the composer's creative thinking. Ballet is a type of performing arts in which the content of the work is expressed through musical choreographic images, which combine types of art as drama, music. such choreography, fine arts, all of which exist separately. Imay is subject to choreography, which is the synthesis center of ballet. The ballet is created in collaboration with the librettoist, composer, choreographer and artist. Unlike the libretto, the dramatic basis of the ballet is that it clearly defines the main content, ideas, contradictions and characters of the work. The libretto is often based on a literary work, with the possibility of embodying it in music and choreography. Based on the script, the composer creates ballet music. Its sequence, scenery, curtains and numbers are shown in the script. Music not only expresses the script, but also enriches it with the content of musical images. Ballet music is the basis for choreography. Ballet is a drama written in music and embodied in choreography. The art of dance develops students not only to acquire movement skills, but also the ability to perform their creative tasks independently. The content of the dance encourages them to think, reason, and express their thoughts orally. The scope of students 'thinking expands. Through the performance of movements, listening to music and memorizing movements increase alertness, concentration, and physical labor. As a result, students' acting and performance skills are improved. Attitudes, aesthetics, and emotions are imprinted on their minds.
