



Formation Of Speech Skills In Students In The Russian Language When Working With Text

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ABSTRACT

The article identifies and substantiates the feasibility of using text in the process of forming communicative, linguistic, linguistic and cultural competences of schoolchildren; presents an analysis of the text as the highest unit of teaching speech activity; suggests criteria for selecting texts when teaching the native language; provides methodological recommendations for organizing the process of forming coherent speech of schoolchildren on a text basis.

Unfortunately, to this day the Mordvin (Moksha, Erzya) languages, both in the field of theory and in the field of methods of their teaching, experience a large deficit of scientific, educational and teaching-method literature. Such a deficit is characteristic, first of all, for higher educational institutions, but it also covers the school education system. Meanwhile, in recent decades, Russian and foreign linguistics has focused on the analysis of text and text units, which is dictated by the needs of both linguistics itself and its applied areas, as well as the needs of literary criticism, pedagogy, psychology, etc. However, in Mordvin linguistics, the development of issues related to the study of the text, its text-forming, educational and other functions, is unreasonably delayed. The novelty and little study of the problem require thorough developments and research in this scientific field, which determines the relevance of our work. The purpose of the article is to determine the role of text in language education and training of students of the national school. It should be noted that the fundamental changes in the life of our society have affected all spheres of its activity, including public education.

Particularly significant were the changes that took place in national schools in various regions, where the process of teaching all subjects has undergone significant changes. In the Republic of Mordovia, in particular, as in the whole of Russia, a new educational situation has developed, which is characterized by increased ethnicization of the content of education, an increasing role of the native language of instruction. According to W. Humboldt, material and spiritual culture are embodied in language; every culture is national, its national character is expressed in language through a special vision of the world; language has an internal form specific to each people, which is an expression of the "national spirit", its culture; language is an intermediary link between man and the world around him [6, p. 73]. The concepts of "communicative competence", "language competence", "linguistic competence", "cultural competence" have entered the standard of a modern comprehensive school. In order for students to master the above-mentioned competencies, special attention at school must be paid to targeted systematic work on developing oral and written speech of

schoolchildren in native language lessons. In modern conditions, when the volume of necessary knowledge is rapidly increasing, it is no longer possible to limit ourselves to mastering a certain amount of knowledge: it is important to develop in students the need and ability to constantly replenish their knowledge and skills, to navigate the rapid flow of scientific and political information. To achieve this task, each member of society needs well-developed speech. The development of cognitive activity and independence of the younger generation largely depends on how well schoolchildren master their native language, speech skills and abilities. The functional aspect in studying the native language at school, the focus on the communicative process inevitably led to the identification of a higher-order communicative unit through which speech is carried out as a historically established form of verbal communication between people. Such a unit is a text, which is a dynamic unit organized in the conditions of real communication.

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
