- 6. In-depth study of the content of professions. He unites students into groups or microgroups based on their interests. In this case, various forms of district organization of work are used. Pupils write essays on their own, conduct excursions.
- 7. Optional training. In some schools, a certain part of the hours allocated to optional classes is used for career guidance. When the profession is chosen correctly, they can better realize their abilities and interests and bring more benefits to society.
