The characteristic features of the essay, first of all, are confidential intonation, simplicity, ease of perception of what is written. It is equally important that the created text be emotional, have artistic brightness and accuracy.

Today, writing an essay is not limited by strict rules and is free. It should also be

remembered that the text must be harmonious. where all parts are interconnected by a common logic, style and a clear author's position. The structure of the essay is determined by the requirements for it: the author's thoughts on the problem are presented in the form of brief abstracts and supported by evidence. Therefore, the thesis is followed by arguments that are expressed in the form of events, life situations, opinions of people and scientists, scientific confirmations and evidence. For persuasiveness, two arguments are usually used[2,58]. Questions are usually arranged in ascending order, from weak to strong. Thanks to this, the argument becomes convincing and logical. Thus, the essay has a ring structure depending on the topic, theses, arguments and logical development of thought: introduction. thesis. arguments, conclusion.

The introduction is characterized by the formulation of the problem and the indication of different points of view on the problem. The main part is a logical part, the presentation of which can go from complex to simple and vice versa. At the beginning of the essay, the author adheres to one point of view and expresses his own point of view in its favor. Then he presents the opposite point of view and explains why he agrees or disagrees with it.

In conclusion, there are two different opinions about this problem. The author himself indicates the point of view that he personally adheres to. A distinctive feature of writing an essay is the fact that the introduction and conclusion should be focused on the problem. So, in the introduction the problem is posed, and in the conclusion it is analyzed and summarized. The integrity of the work is achieved by highlighting red lines and building a logical chain of statements.

The style of the essay can be different - artistic, emotional, expressive. Skillful use of speech turns, simple, clear and short phrases will create the desired effect. The formation of essay writing skills is expressed in the use of lexical and grammatical constructions. This is what develops the critical thinking of students,

forcing them to look for new ways to prove their own point of view [1,87].

Knowledge of language cliches, introductory phrases that give emotional coloring and expressiveness of the text are a prerequisite for writing an essay in a foreign language. Critical Thinking Technology helps develop these skills by focusing on qualities such as mental flexibility and control over one's own thinking. Students are actively involved in the learning process, which is as close to reality as possible.
